Respect the planet at the table

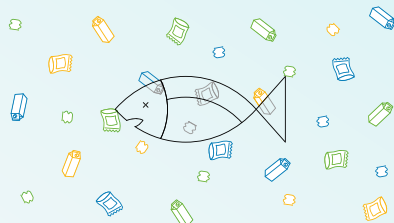

Smart tourism destination

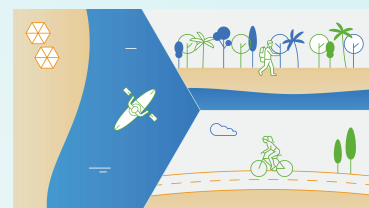
Did you know that 24 trees are needed to make a ton of paper? In Santa Susanna, we've signed up to the digital transformation by making lots of paperless resources available.

A mosaic of landscapes to discover

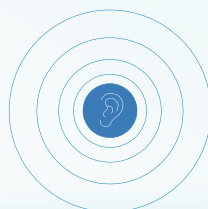

Silence, peace, and health

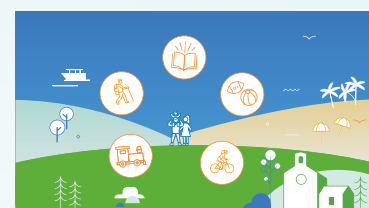
